- Sec. 2. Review. The Maine Arts Commission shall conduct a review of the process associated with a school's or a nonprofit public agency's applying for and obtaining funds from the State Poet Laureate Reimbursement Fund, established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 27, section 424, after the process has been in place for 3 years and make any necessary adjustments by September 30, 2006. The commission may submit to the Legislature any legislation necessary to implement recommendations resulting from the review.'

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#### **SUMMARY**

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This amendment strikes and replaces the bill to provide an alternative approach to achieving the intent of the bill, which establishes the State Poet Laureate Reimbursement Fund within the Maine Arts Commission. The amendment replaces the General Fund account proposed in the bill with an Other Special Revenue Funds account and clarifies that the fund administered by commission may provide funds to nonprofit public agencies and to schools in Maine to reimburse the State Poet Laureate for the cost of travel and related expenses associated with bringing the services of the State Poet Laureate to the community. amendment also requires the commission to conduct a review of the process of applying for and obtaining funds once the process has been in place for 3 years and to implement any necessary adjustments by September 30, 2006. The amendment further requires the Maine Arts Commission to promote the State Poet Laureate Reimbursement Fund through its various avenues of communication, including its publicly accessible site on the Internet.
