During the First Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature, the joint standing committee of the Legislature

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having jurisdiction over agricultural matters may report out legislation regarding the definition of "Maine Standardbred horse."

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#### 6 SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. It allows the State Harness Racing Commission to register as a Maine Standardbred horse offspring produced during a year in which the offspring's sire was registered and stabled in Maine for breeding purposes. The State Harness Racing Commission is required to report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over agricultural matters on the breeding of Maine Standardbred horses and to make recommendations regarding the definition of "Maine Standardbred horse."
