Resolve, to Create the Department of Fisheries and Wildlife

Sec. 1. Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; Department of Marine Resources; Atlantic Salmon Commission; abolished. Resolved: 2 That effective 90 days after the adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, the Department of Marine Resources and the Atlantic Salmon Commission are abolished; and be it further Sec. 2. Plan and legislation submitted. Resolved: 10 Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall, in consultation with the Department of Inland Fisheries 12

- Wildlife, the Department of Marine Resources and the Atlantic Salmon Commission, develop and submit to the Legislature by November 1, 2003 legislation that accomplishes the following:
- 16 Reorganizes the Department of Inland Fisheries Wildlife, the Department of Marine Resources and the Atlantic Salmon Commission into a single Department of Fisheries and 18 Wildlife with the same responsibilities and duties as the current 20 departments and commissions;
- 22 2. Amends relevant laws to conform to the reorganization;
- 3. Provides a budget for the new department; and 24
- 26 4. Specifies all positions that will be eliminated or reclassified.

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30 **SUMMARY**

32 This resolve accomplishes the following:

- Abolishes the Department of Inland Fisheries Wildlife, the Department of Marine Resources and the Atlantic Salmon Commission 90 days after the adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature; and
- Requires the Commissioner of Administrative Financial Services, in consultation with the Department of Inland 40 Fisheries and Wildlife, the Department of Marine Resources and 42 the Atlantic Salmon Commission, to develop and submit to the Legislature by November 1, 2003 legislation that reorganizes the 44 3 agencies into a new Department of Fisheries and Wildlife.
