Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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(7) Employment tax increment financing under Title 36,
chapter 917; or

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~~(8) -- The shipbuilding facility credit under Title 36,
30 chapter 919; or~~

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(9) The credit for seed capital investment under Title
36, section 5216-B.

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Sec. 2. 36 MRSA c. 919, as amended, is repealed.

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SUMMARY

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This bill repeals the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36,
chapter 919, which is the chapter that created the shipbuilding
