28	3. Retail price. With each prescription dispensed, the pharmacist shall disclose to the patient in writing the usual and
30	customary price of the prescription and the cost of any payment toward the price required of the patient.
32	Sec. 2. Application. The provisions of the Maine Revised
34	Statutes, Title 32, section 13874, subsection 3 apply to a pharmacy beginning January 1, 2006 or when the pharmacy updates
36	its computer software program with regard to prescription drug price and patient payment, whichever occurs first.'

42	This amendment removes the requirement that price
44	information be provided on the label, removes the restriction to new prescriptions only and removes the requirement that price information be provided on the receipt. It requires disclosure

in writing of the usual and customary price and the payment required of the patient when a prescription is filled. The amendment applies these requirements January 1, 2006 or when computer software with regard to prescription drug price and patient payment is updated by a pharmacy, whichever occurs first.
