Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:	
Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6403-B is enacted to read:	
§6403-B. Healthy eating in schools	
By September 1, 2003, the department shall adopt rules providing for healthy eating in schools. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A. Rules adopted pursuant to this section must meet the requirements of this section.	
1. All schools. In all schools, sales of the following	
foods and drinks are prohibited whether by school nutrition	
program, vending machine or competitive food sales: chewing gum candy bars, food or drinks that are 35% or more sugar or other sweeteners, juices that are less than 100% real fruit juice and	
foods with greater than 8 grams of fat per serving.	
 2. Elementary and middle schools. In elementary and middle schools sales of soft drinks are prohibited. 3. High schools. In high schools sales of soft drinks 	
containing sugar or caffeine are prohibited.	
4. Exemption. Contractual agreements for the sale of food or drinks in all schools that were in effect on January 1, 200	
and sales of food and drinks under those contracts are exemp	
from the application of the rules adopted pursuant to thi section.	
SUMMARY	
This bill directs the Department of Education to adopt rule	
to prohibit the sale in schools of certain foods and drinks.
