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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 49, L.D. 126, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Membership of the Propane and Natural Gas Board"

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Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 22 to 24 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

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'Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "8 9" and inserting in its place the following: '8'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the first line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Five members representing industry, 3" and inserting in its place the following: 'Five Four members representing industry, 3 2'

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Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 (page 1, lines 36 to 49 and page 2, line 1 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 2. Transition. When a person representing a labor organization becomes a member of the Propane and Natural Gas Board, the member of the board who represents the propane industry who has the least amount of time remaining in that member's term on the board ceases to be a member of the board.'



SUMMARY

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This amendment maintains the membership of the Propane and Natural Gas Board at 8 members. It retains the provision of the bill that exempts the member representing a labor organization from the requirement of at least 10 consecutive years of active experience in the propane or the natural gas industry immediately preceding appointment. It also strikes the appropriation section from the amendment.
