COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 49, L.D. 126, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Membership of the Propane and Natural Gas Board"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1, lines 10 and 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the member representing a labor organization"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph C-1 (page 1, lines 34 and 35 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'C-1. One member representing a labor organization in the pipe-fitting industry; and'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

This is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Business, Research and Economic Development.
