	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7035, sub-§1, ¶¶C and D are enacted to read:
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б	<u>C. Trapping rules must be published separately from hunting rules.</u>
8	D. All rules published by the department, including advertisements, notices and reminders published in the same
10	document as the rules, must be published on paper that is
	uniform in size and weight, except the front and back
12	covers. This paragraph does not apply to rules published
	<u>electronically.</u>

18	This bill requires that the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife publish trapping rules separately from hunting rules
20	and that the department publish rules on paper that is uniform in size and weight.
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
