Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§12, as amended by PL 2001, c. 202,
4	\$1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
6	12. Hunting without hunter orange clothing. A person is
	guilty of hunting without hunter orange clothing if that person
8	hunts with firearms during the open firearm season on deer and
	fails to wear a solid-colored hunter orange hat, except that
10	<u>persons hunting water waterfowl from a boat or blind or in</u>
	conjunction with waterfowl decoys need not wear hunter orange
12	<u>clothing.</u>

	This bill changes the requirement of wearing 2 articles of
18	hunter orange clothing, one of which must be a hat, to only
	needing to wear a hunter orange hat.
