28	A person who violates this subsection commits a Class E crime.
30	SUMMARY
32	This bill defines twilight hunting as occurring between sunset and 15 minutes afterward and night hunting as occurring 15
34	minutes after sunset to 30 minutes before sunrise. The bill clarifies that twilight hunting is a Class E crime.
