Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. P&SL 1875, c. 57, §4, as enacted by P&SL 1991, c. 101,
4 §1 and repealed by §3, is reenacted to read:

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Sec. 4. The Town of Medway is authorized to sell or lease,
with the approval of a majority of the voters, any real estate
8 that the town owns. Any funds received from the sale of
ministerial lands designated for a particular use must be used
10 for the purposes originally designated.

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Sec. 2. Repeal. This Act is repealed on January 1, 2013.

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SUMMARY

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This bill allows the Town of Medway to sell certain land.
