Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5219-W is enacted to read:
§5219-W. Credit for homeschooling
A taxpayer who is providing homeschooling for one or more
dependents as approved by the Commissioner of Education as
equivalent instruction through home instruction pursuant to Title
20-A, section 5001-A, subsection 3, paragraph A, subparagraph (3
is entitled to a credit of \$1,000 against the taxes imposed unde
this Part. The credit may not reduce the state income tax
liability to less than zero.
SUMMARY
This bill provides a nonrefundable income tax credit o
\$1,000 to taxpayers who provide approved homeschooling for their
dependents.
