Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

0	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
8	This bill proposes to move current oversight of
10	state-approved school construction projects from the Department of Administrative and Financial Service, Bureau of General
12	Services to the Department of Education.
14	The purpose of this change would be to create a single oversight and service entity, so that all of the major functions,
16	from application through final project completion, associated with school construction projects are delivered from a single
18	agency.
20	Under the bill, fees currently collected by the Bureau of General Services would be assigned to the Department of Education
22	to support the additional responsibility the Department of Education would assume. Position counts at the Bureau of General
24	Services would be transferred to the Department of Education as necessary.
