44	This amendment replaces the language of the bill to authorize a municipality to dispose of unclaimed bicycles in any
46	manner that the legislative body of the municipality decides is appropriate. Current law authorizes sale at a public auction,
48	and the bill would have allowed donations to charitable organizations.
