	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2051, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

	4. Multilane highway. On a highway with more than 2 lanes
б	in the same direction, a commercial motor vehicle is restricted
	in ordinary operation to the right-hand lane and in overtaking
8	and passing is restricted to the next adjacent travel lane and
	may not use any other lanes except in an emergency. For purposes
10	of this section, "commercial motor vehicle" means a vehicle in
	excess of 2 1/2 tons used for transportation of goods, wares and
12	<u>merchandise.</u>

	This bill prohibits a commercial motor vehicle from
18	travelling in the far left lane on a multilane highway.
