on the Little River, known as "the Little River Dam," located in
Cumberland County near the Town of Scarborough for problems with
flooding or with the effective operation of the dam's fishway and
fish trap; and be it further

department's findings and may submit legislation necessary to
resolve issues identified in the report to the joint standing

This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve and requires the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to monitor the dam on the Little River located near the Town of Scarborough for problems with flooding or with the effective operation of the dam's fishway and fish trap. The resolve requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to report back the department's finding along with any recommended legislation to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife matters by January 1, 2006.
