

HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 156, L.D. 197, Bill, "An Act to Require Flashing Lights for Private Snow Plows"

Amend the amendment in subparagraph (4) in the 4th line from the end (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "locations" the following: 'except when the vehicle is being used for plowing for which the owner or operator of the vehicle is not being compensated'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the lights are not required if the vehicle is being used for plowing for which the plow owner or operator is not receiving compensation.
