Sec. 1. Waiver application. Resolved: That, by January 1, 2004, the Department of Human Services shall submit a waiver application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to expand community-based options for elderly and disabled persons. The waiver application must seek to expand the in-home and community-based services waiver for senior assisted housing to cover a wider variety of services and service settings. Rules to implement the waiver adopted pursuant to this provision are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

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## **SUMMARY**

This resolve requires the Department of Human Services to submit a waiver application by January 1, 2004 to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to expand community-based options for elderly and disabled persons.
