#### **SUMMARY**

2 This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires the Foster/Adoptive Parent Advisory Committee to deliver an oral and written report to the joint standing committee of the 6 Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters every 6 months. The amendment specifies the contents of the report. The amendment also requires the Foster/Adoptive Parent Advisory Committee to have cochairs and requires that one of the cochairs must be a foster or adoptive parent. 10
