22	2/3 of all of the members elected to each House have determined
32	it necessary to enact this measure.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 204, L.D. 249

### SUMMARY

This amendment adds a mandate preamble to the bill and 6 replaces the bill. The amendment requires the chief administrative officer of each municipal, county and state law enforcement agency to certify to the board of trustees of the 8 Maine Criminal Justice Academy annually that the agency has 10 adopted a written policy regarding procedures to deal with a freedom of access request and that the chief has designated a person who is trained to respond to freedom of access requests 12 received by the agency.
