Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§23-C, ¶¶D and E, as enacted by PL
4 1999, c. 759, §2 and affected by §5, are amended to read:

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D. Truck bodies and trailers manufactured in the State; and

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E. Camper trailers, including truck campers; and

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Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§23-C, ¶F is enacted to read:

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F. Special mobile equipment.
