SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 217, L.D. 274, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part F the following:

PART G

Sec. G-1. PL 2003, c. 333, §22 is repealed.

Sec. G-2. Effective date. That section of this Part that repeals Public Law 2003, chapter 333, section 22 takes effect September 13, 2003.'


Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

Public Law 2003, chapter 333 repealed the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 7464, subsection 7, which prohibits the illegal possession of a gift moose, and Title 12, section 7464, subsection 8, which prohibits the buying and selling of moose. Although the repeal of Title 12, section 7467, subsection 7 was intentional, Title 12, section 7467, subsection 8 was repealed in error. This amendment repeals the section of chapter 333 that repeals subsection 8, thus leaving subsection 8 in

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force. Further, it makes the change effective September 13,  
2003, which is the date chapter 333 takes effect.
