

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment includes a General Fund appropriation for the Department of Public Safety to cover the costs of processing background checks for new certified nursing assistants; the amounts are \$57,287 and \$65,000 in fiscal years 2003-04 and 2004-05, respectively.

Beginning in fiscal year 2003-04, the background check fees for new certified nursing assistants will generate an estimated \$65,000 in annual General Fund revenue.
