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SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment replaces the resolve. It deletes the portions of the 40 resolve pertaining to InforME and the portions pertaining to access to criminal history record information. It retains the 42 provision on payment for criminal history record checks for the Maine Registry of Certified Nursing Assistants. It requires the 44 Department of Public Safety to amend the rules regarding criminal history record checks to grant free access to the Maine Registry 46 of Certified Nursing Assistants. It requires rulemaking by the Department of Education on including the cost of the first record 48
