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#### 10 SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the original concept draft with a resolve requiring that the Secretary of State study the issue of titling mobile homes, boats, all-terrain vehicles, snowmobiles and other similar types of property not already titled in this State. The Secretary of State shall include interested parties and report back before January 15, 2004 with recommendations. The Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary is authorized to report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature.
