34	SUMMARY
34	This amendment decreases the monetary amount at which a
36	written home construction contract is required from \$5,000 in the bill to \$3,000. It also allows a change in the commencement and
38	completion dates of a project if the contractor is unable to work at the project site due to circumstances beyond the control of
40	the contractor, whereas the bill specified only the lack of readiness of the site or the unavailability of building materials.

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
