Potential current biennium cost increase - General Fund

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This Resolve allows the State to be sued up to a maximum amount of \$400,000 including costs and interest. If the plaintiff is successful, a General Fund appropriation for the recovery will be necessary. The amount and timing of the appropriation will depend on whether the suit is filed and its outcome. The Department of the Attorney General and the Department of Corrections can absorb the additional costs of defending this claim within existing resources. The Judicial Department can absorb the workload and administrative costs associated with this individual case within its existing resources. An additional filing fee will increase General Fund revenue by a minor amount.
