COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 233, L.D. 290, Bill, "An Act To Ensure That Title Applications are Timely Delivered"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §603, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

4. **Penalty.** If an application, certificate of title or other document required to be delivered to the Secretary of State is not delivered to the Secretary of State within 20 days, the Secretary of State shall collect, \$125 as a penalty, ~~an amount equal to the fee required for the transaction.~~

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment allows the Secretary of State to collect a \$125 penalty if an application, certificate of title or other document required to be delivered to the Secretary of State is not delivered to the Secretary of State within 20 days.

Changing the penalty for the late filing of motor vehicle title applications will increase Highway Fund revenues collected by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles within the Department of the Secretary of State. The estimated revenue increases are \$34,013 and \$45,350 in fiscal years 2003-04 and 2004-05, respectfully.
