Notwithstanding section 7901-A, a 12 law enforcement officer, as defined in Title 25, section 2801-A, subsection 5, must issue a warning to a person who violates this subparagraph for the first 14 time. 16 (2) Feed, set bait for or harass any endangered or threatened species. #### SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and makes an intentional violation of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 7756, subsection 1-A a Class D crime and a negligent violation of Title 12, section 7756, subsection 1 a Class E crime. These sections concern prohibited acts regarding endangered or threatened species.
