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8 SUMMARY

This amendment revises the bill to provide more clarity as to who other than clergy should be required to report suspected child abuse or neglect and suspected abuse, neglect or exploitation of vulnerable adults. This amendment includes as a mandatory reporter any person affiliated with a church or religious institution who serves in an administrative capacity or has otherwise assumed a position of trust or responsibility to the members of that church or religious institution. Such a person is required to report if that person obtains the information of suspected abuse, neglect or exploitation while acting in that administrative capacity. The obligation applies regardless of whether the person receives compensation.
