•	The Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 8 provides
8	that all taxes on real estate be "apportioned and assessed
	equally according to the just value thereof." This resolve

	is in place to effectuate this constitutional requirement to
12	ensure that the process of property valuation is carried out
	equitably and efficiently, and proposes changes to improve the
14	functioning of the process.
