#### R. of S. COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to S.P. 108, L.D. 326 Limitation. Tuition waivers to eligible persons are 2 limited to 25 30 new students per year in each year at state postsecondary educational institutions as follows: A. The first 25 tuition waivers must be available to eligible persons at the University of Maine System, the Maine Maritime Academy and the Maine Community College System; and 10 B. Of the 5 remaining tuition waivers, 3 must be available to eligible persons at the University of Maine System and 2 must be available to eligible persons at the Maine Community 12 College System. 14 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.' 16 18 SUMMARY 20 This amendment strikes and replaces the bill. The amendment increases the number of foster care residents who are eligible 22 a tuition waiver at state postsecondary educational institutions from 25 to 30 new students per year in each year, 24 whereas the bill increased the number to 35. The amendment also clarifies that the 5 additional tuition waivers must be available 26 eligible persons at state postsecondary educational 28 institutions as follows: Three must be available to eligible persons at the 30 University of Maine System; and 32

2. Two must be available to eligible persons at the Maine Community College System.

The amendment also adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause to the bill.
