_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12573, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1999, c.
4	774, §4, is further amended to read:
6	3. Limitation. Tuition waivers to eligible persons are limited to 25 35 new students per year in each year.

10	SUMMARY
12	This bill increases the number of foster care residents who are eligible for a tuition waiver at a state postsecondary
14	educational institution from 25 to 35 new students per year in each year.
