B	e it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1499-A is enacted to read:

	1. Prohibition. Except as provided in subsection 2, a
_	erson may not initiate a solicitation call to a person in this
	tate if the caller blocks or causes the blocking of the caller's
	elephone number so that it will not be displayed on the
	eceiving party's caller identification device.
	2. Exceptions. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply
t	0:
	A. A person who makes fewer than 300 solicitation calls in
	any 12-month period;
	B. A person who has an established business relationship
	with the person called; or
	C. A person making solicitations on behalf of a charitable
	organization as defined in Title 9, section 5003.
	3. Penalty. Violation of this section is an unfair trade
2	ractice as prohibited by Title 5, section 207.
