2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §550-B, sub-§7** is enacted to read:

6 7. Well cap information. After completion of any well or
8 the enlarging or deepening of an existing well, a well contractor
shall provide information on the well cap indicating the date
drilled, the depth of the well and the well yield rate.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill requires well contractors to provide information
14 on the caps of drilled wells indicating the date drilled, the
depth of the well and the well yield rate.
