26	'Sec. 1. Authority to convey easement. Resolved: That, in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section
28	6209, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife may as provided in this section enter into an amendment of the
30	conservation easement that the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife holds in the Rangeley River conservation corridor and
32	that was acquired with funds from the Land for Maine's Future Fund. If the commissioner finds that the conservation values of
34	the Rangeley River conservation corridor will not be adversely affected, the commissioner may allow the Oquossoc Standard Water
36	District to drill for water within 20 feet of the existing waterline on the property, to construct one or more wells within
38	20 feet of the existing waterline on the property and to connect the wells to the existing waterline in order to provide potable
40	water to the Village of Oquossoc in the Town of Rangeley.'
