A person who owns or keeps a dangerous dog commits a civil violation for which a-forfeiture-of-not-more-than-\$1,000,-plus eests,-may-be-adjudged the court shall adjudge a fine of not less than \$250 and not more than \$1,000, plus costs, none of which may be suspended.'

This amendment removes section 1 of the bill, which proposed increasing the fine for violation of the uncontrolled dog laws. It amends the proposed penalty for keeping a dangerous dog to specify that the fine may not be suspended.
