An Act To Change the Display of ATV Registration Numbers

4	§39, is further amended to read:
6	1. Application, issuance and decal specifications. The commissioner, or an agent designated by the commissioner, may
8	register and assign a registration number to any ATV upon application and payment of an annual fee by the owner. The
10	commissioner shall charge a fee of \$1 in addition to the annual
	fee for each registration issued by an employee of the
12	department. The registration number must be clearly displayed on the rear of the vehicle. A registration is valid for one year
14	commencing July 1st of each year. The following specifications
	apply to ATV registration number decals and their issuance.

	A. The department shall issue sequentially numbered decals
18	to each agent designated by the commissioner for ATV
	registration purposes. An agent shall distribute a decal to
20	a registration applicant as a means of assigning the
	registration number. Decals must:
22	
24	(1) Be 4 inches by 4 inches in size;
24	(2) Display a 5-digit registration number, that is as
26	large as possible;
28	(3) Display an expiration date;
30	(4) Display the words "Maine ATV"; and
32	(5) Use a background color that vividly contrasts with the color of the numbers and letters. A different
34	background color should be used each year.
36	B. The department or an agent designated by the commissioner
38	<pre>for ATV registration purposes, when issuing a registration number decal, shall provide an applicant with:</pre>
40	(1) A diagram depicting where the registration number decal must be placed on the vehicle to provide optimum
42	visibility;
44	(2) Written instructions that an expired registration number decal must be removed from the ATV or completely
46	covered; and
48	(3) Written educational information about ATV laws and safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	C. An agent issuing ATV registration number decals shall
2	notify an applicant that by signing the ATV registration the
	applicant is affirming that the applicant is aware of and
4	understands the laws governing ATV registration and use in
	the State.

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SUMMARY

This bill requires the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to issue ATV registration decals and provide applicants with certain information regarding ATV registration, use and laws.
