Further amend the resolve in section 6 in the last line (page 2, line 46 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "meetings" the following: 'and, upon a demonstration of financial hardship, a per diem equal to the legislative per diem for their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission'

Further amend the resolve in section 7 in the 2nd line (page 8 2, line 49 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "advance its work" and inserting in its place the following: 'support the 10 study' '

12 Further amend the amendment on pages 2 and 3 by striking out all of section 8 (page 2, lines 47 to 52 and page 3, lines 1 to 6 14 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 8. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall submit a report that includes its findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature no later than December 3, 2003. If the commission requires an extension of time to complete its report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension.
Following review of the report, the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety may report out a bill related to the study to the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature; and be it further'

SUMMARY

30 This amendment accomplishes the following:

 32 1. It alters the language that allows the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court to designate a judge or justice to
 34 serve on the commission;

- 36 2. It requires the commission chairs, rather then the Executive Director of the Legislative Council, to convene the 38 commission;
- 40 3. It reduces from 6 to 4 the number of meetings authorized for the commission;

4. It authorizes reimbursement of expenses to public 44 members upon a showing of financial hardship;

46 5. It authorizes the commission to submit its report to the
 Legislature, rather than to the Joint Standing Committee on
 48 Criminal Justice and Public Safety;
