2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §1574, sub-§3,** as repealed by PL 2001, c. 325,  
§3, is reenacted to read:

6 **3. Juvenile offenders.** If a juvenile court adjudicates a  
8 juvenile to have committed a juvenile crime that, if committed by  
10 an adult, would constitute an offense listed in this section,  
12 then the juvenile is subject to the requirements of this section.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 The bill subjects a juvenile to DNA testing requirements if  
18 the juvenile is adjudicated of committing a juvenile crime that,  
if committed by an adult, would constitute an offense listed in  
the DNA Data Base and Data Bank Act.
