24 Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated
26 "~~§708-A.~~" by striking out all of the last underlined sentence
(page 1, lines 12 to 16 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the
following:

'A certificate of approval holder, wholesale licensee or retail
licensee shall provide information about access to participate in
a sweepstakes, game or contest by providing either a sign in the
retail outlet or a notice on the primary or secondary packaging
of the brand offering the sweepstakes, game or contest.'
