Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6101, sub-§2, ¶D is enacted to read:

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D. Notwithstanding paragraph B, a school administrative unit may release information in any form relating to an employee or former employee to another school administrative unit when the other school administrative unit requests the information for the purpose of a reference for employment.

SUMMARY

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This bill allows a school administrative unit to release confidential information about an employee or former employee to another school administrative unit for the purpose of a reference for employment.
