The amendment allows Sunday hunting in wildlife management 40 districts 1, 2, 4 and 5 for ruffed grouse, rabbit, squirrel and woodcock during the regular open season for those species. 42 This amendment sets an effective date of January 1, 2005 and 44 a repeal date of January 1, 2007.
