HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 134, L.D. 397, Bill, "An Act To Study the Development of an Emergency Alert Notification System for Deaf and Hard-of-hearing Individuals"

Amend the amendment in section 7 in the 2nd line (page 4, line 10 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "entitled to" the following: 'a'


Further amend the amendment in section 8 in the 6th line (page 4, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "legislation" and inserting in its place the following: 'a bill'

Further amend the amendment in section 8 in the last 2 lines (page 4, lines 20 and 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "; and be it further" and inserting in its place the following: '.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 9.

SUMMARY

This amendment authorizes the Study Group to Examine an Emergency Alert Notification System for Deaf and Hard-of-hearing Individuals to report out a single bill related to the study. It removes the provision allowing the study group an extension of time to complete its study and it makes a clerical change.
