### SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. Like the bill, it removes the language from the law that makes possessing hunting equipment in a motor vehicle on an unpaved highway or road located in an unorganized township on Sunday prima facie evidence of a violation of the Sunday-hunting law. The amendment also repeals the law that makes possessing a loaded firearm on or near a public paved way prima facie evidence of hunting.
