2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 24-A MRS §2556** is enacted to read:

6 **§2556. Spousal beneficiaries**

8 A person who was previously married or in a domestic
10 relationship may cancel a life insurance policy in that person's
name that was purchased by the person's spouse or domestic
partner during the marriage or domestic relationship.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill allows a formerly married person or former
16 domestic partner to cancel a life insurance policy in that
18 person's name that was purchased by the person's former spouse or
domestic partner during the marriage or domestic relationship.
