One provider member must be a chiropractor chosen from a list provided by a statewide chiropractic association. One provider member must be a representative, chosen from a list provided by the Maine Ambulatory--Gare--Gealitien Primary Care Association, of a federally qualified health center. One provider member must be a pharmacist chosen from a list provided by the Maine Pharmacy Association. One provider member must be a mental health provider chosen from a list provided by the Maine Association of Mental Health Services. Two One provider members member must be-representatives -ef ether-health-care-providers,-at-least-one-of-whom-is-a eurrent-representative-ef represent a home health care company.'

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment deletes the provision increasing the number of members of the Board of Directors of the Maine Health Data Organization from 20 to 21. The amendment requires that one of the 9 members of the board representing providers be a mental health provider.
