COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 332, L.D. 424, Bill, "An Act To Increase the Availability of Handicapped Parking Spaces for People with Disabilities"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1, 2 and 3.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes 3 sections from the original bill. It retains the provision that allows municipalities to apply time limits to parking spaces reserved for persons with disabilities.
