	Under current law, adaptive equipment installed on a motor
14	vehicle owned by a disabled person to make the vehicle operable
	or accessible by a disabled person is exempt from the excise
16	tax. This bill exempts from sales tax the sales of adaptive
	equipment to a disabled person or a disabled person's family
18	member for installation in or on a motor vehicle to make the vehicle accessible by a disabled person.
